



Case Study - Signs and Lines Review

The Project

A Local Authority based in the South East was looking at introducing a parking scheme incorporating new controlled parking zones in and around a town centre. In order to gain an accurate picture of the potential physical works needed to implement the scheme, Alpha Parking was commissioned to survey the current signs and lines and report on their state of repair and compliance with TSRDG standards.

The Solution

Alpha Parking uses a fourfold process when conducting a full signs and lines review:

- Reviewing the signs and lines against the established traffic orders;
- Checking compliance with TSRGD 2002 standards;
- Examining the appropriateness of the restrictions in place.
- Collecting highway asset data

By carrying out these three simultaneous processes, Alpha Parking constructed reports which give both a concise overview of the signs, lines and traffic order situation as well as detailed appendices of the specific problems found. In this case, Alpha Parking was able to highlight long-term faults which would significantly undermine enforcement of current and future restrictions. By establishing the nature and extent of the potential changes required, the local authority was able to improve their enforcement and management of the local parking environment.
